Cable System or System: Shall be defined herein as it is defined under Section 602 of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 522(7).

STONEHAM, MASS (June 2006) Pop 22,219 (N of Boston) (Note re Massachusetts: our research shows at least 12 Verizon franchises in Mass that have used the federal law definition, 12 more towns with the federal law definition and some additional language, and another 12 that have accepted Verizon's "lightwave" distinction)
