Subject: MHCRC Alleged Noncompliance Process

Hi Raymond: It was good to talk with you today and look forward to meeting with you soon. As mentioned today, I wanted to provide you some clarifications about the "noncompliance" process under the Gresham franchise (Section 14) to address the issue of the PEG access channels not currently being included in the video service being offered in Gresham. According to our records, Verizon received, via USPS, the noncompliance notice on December 3, 2008, in the form of a letter from me dated Nov. 25, 2008 (you received this letter via email on Nov. 25 also). Within 30 days from receipt (by January 2, 2009), Verizon must cure or initiate good faith efforts satisfactory to the Commission to cure the noncompliance.

The MHCRC has its regularly scheduled meeting on December 15 at 6:45 pm. We intend to have the alleged noncompliance issue on the agenda as an informational item. I would encourage a Verizon representative to attend this meeting in order to discuss Verizon's plans to address the issue and to respond to any questions Commissioners may have. We are also open to including any information on this issue from Verizon in the MHCRC's meeting packet. We would need to receive any materials for inclusion in the packet no later than Tuesday, Dec. 9, 2008.

Currently, we have Renee Willer, Larry Manion and you on our Commission meeting notice and packet list. Are these the correct Verizon representatives to include going forward? _____
